We will parade through the city centre to the cathedral together with other members of the Scout Association from across the City of Peterborough, and all those who have been invested into the movement will renew the Scout Promise together.

- All uniformed members are asked to make a special effort to attend, wearing full (smart) Uniform;
- Polished black shoes
 - Dark plain socks
 - Scout Uniform Trousers or Dark grey or airforce blue smart trousers
 - Scout Belt – polished leather and shining buckle.
 - Beavers and Cubs should wear their sweatshirts with all badges neatly sewn on
 - Scouts should wear their shirt with all badges neatly sewn on and shirt buttons done up.
 - Neckerchief (ironed and rolled)
 - Woggle appropriate to section

Sections parading in fancy dress should parade in full correct uniform, fancy dress will be worn over uniform

If the weather is cold wear a tracksuit or similar beneath so it is not visible through your uniform.

If it rains, a waterproof coat may be worn (or carried if only threatened).

Parade and Service

The parade will assemble on Stanley Recreation Ground, Stanley Rd (off Broadway) from 13:00.

The parade will move off at 13.30 to Peterborough Cathedral behind a Band, the service will start at 14:00 and last around 40 minutes. The route will be Broadway, Long Causeway, into Cathedral Square to enter the Cathedral Precincts then the Cathedral.

Parents, families, visitors and supporters are welcome to follow the parade into the Cathedral for the service.

During the service there will a collection in aid of the Rudolf Fund, a Peterborough based charity that works to

"Make Christmas Special for Special Children".

After the service the parade will re assemble in Cathedral Precincts to meet the Bishop of Peterborough, the Mayor and Deputy Lord Lieutenant of Cambridgeshire and other guests prior to parading back to Stanley Recreation Ground for dismissal by 3:30pm.
