#### **Adult Help**

The troop leaders will be allocated bases to organise, for which we need help for all or part of the evening. Any adults who would like to help please let Glynis know. If you are only available for part of the evening please specify times.

*Please note that all over 18's taking part in **most** Scout activities involving under 18's must be CRB cleared by the Scout Association prior to helping regularly with activities. **A CRB is not required if you are with and assisting someone who is CRB cleared for a one off occasion.***

#### **Equipment**

At the start patrols will be checked for appropriate equipment & briefed.

#### **ANY SCOUT NOT WEARING THE CORRECT CLOTHING WILL BE SENT HOME**

Scouts will need to wear outdoor clothing suitable for the weather including:

- **Hat & Gloves;**
- Warm Anorak, Fleece or similar;
- Warm Trousers (not denim as they soak up water and are very cold when wet);
- Appropriate footwear for paths &, tracks within Ferry Meadows. Boots are ideal, strong shoes are ok, trainers need to be very strong, Wellingtons will keep the feet dry but can chafe when walking)
- Two pairs of socks;
- Gaiters (if available).

Scouts will need to carry (in a small rucksack or similar):

- Waterproof outer garment (and trousers if available);
- Spare sweater;
- Personal First Aid Kit;
- Torch;
- Water bottle containing drink (cans of drink are not suitable because they cannot be re-closed once opened);
- 'Emergency Rations' / snack food;
- Bring your own paper and Pen or Pencil

**The leader of each group will need a Waterproof Map Case: (collect at a troop meeting)**
